### A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE REBUILD

### ALABAMA TRANSPORTATION PLAN

WHEREAS, During the 2019 Special Session, in an effort to address infrastructure funding, the Legislature passed and the governor approved, House Bill 2 which, among other things, increased the motor fuel tax by 6 cents in 2019, 2 additional cents in 2020, and 2 additional cents in 2021 and increasing funds available for road improvements. House Bill 2 also included the ATRIP-II program which provides for state match program for local projects of public use; and,

WHEREAS for 2019, substantial funds will be available for which local governments may apply. The programs accountability provisions impose certain requirements on the County and Municipalities as to the expenditure of the funds available, specifically, the City is required to adopt an Annual Transportation Plan no later than August 31<sup>st</sup> for the next fiscal year which provides a detailed list of projects for which expenditures are intended to be made in the next fiscal year and shall be based upon an estimate of the revenues anticipated from the fund during the fiscal year.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of LaFayette, Alabama hereby adopts an annual Rebuild Alabama Transportation Plan in accordance with ATRIP-II Rebuild Alabama Infrastructure Program. This plan shall be posted in a conspicuous place in the LaFayette City Hall and on the City of LaFayette website for the duration of the ATRIP II program.
